New Exhibit Opportunity at the West Colfax Event Center **9797 W. Colfax Ave, Lakewood (Corner of Kipling & Colfax)**

The West Colfax Event Center offers community artists the opportunity to exhibit their work in their lobby. Located in the Colfax-Kipling Shopping Center at 9797 W. Colfax, Lakewood (next to the eyeglasses store, at the former location of Purvis Jewelers), the West Colfax Event Center is a 72 seat community theatre, music event center and place for children's acting classes. The Event Center is run by the "E" Project, a theatre group that has been in existence for five years. They have recently moved from a performance location on Garrison to their new location on Colfax. The facility is open during performances on Friday, Saturday, Sunday as well as during classes and special events.

Colorado artists who are at the exhibiting level are invited to display their work on the lobby walls. The space is large and well-lit with overhead florescent lights. Holding from 15-25 pieces (depending on size), it is an ideal location for one, two, or a small group of artists to display their work. Each exhibit will run approximately seven weeks, at a rental fee of \$50. Booking of the exhibit space is handled by the Lakewood Arts Council. Scheduling will be done on a first come basis. Interested artists should submit the enclosed application form. **DO NOT** include the \$50 fee at this time. Fees benefit the Center and will be due at booking confirmation.

SPECIFICS OF EXHIBITS

1. Eligibility: Open to all Colorado artists; exhibiting level only.
2. Exhibits run approximately 7 weeks and change at 9:00 am on Mondays. Artists are responsible for delivery and pick up of their work. Shows are hung by show chairmen.
3. Fee: \$50 per exhibit; fees are non-refundable and are due at the time of booking confirmation. Checks will be made out to "The E Project".
4. Specifications of artwork: Approximately 15 - 25 works per exhibit. Wall hung work only. Original work only; no prints from originals. Work must be framed or have wrapped and finished edges, and be ready for hanging with screw-eyes and wire (no sawtooth hangers!!) Works must be identified on the front with title, medium, price, artist's name. A complete inventory sheet must be provided at delivery.
5. Sales: sales will be handled by the Event Center. Checks / payment will be made directly to the artist. No commission will be charged on sales. (Although security measures for accepting checks, charge, etc. will be followed, the sponsoring agents will not be held accountable.)
6. Insurance: no insurance is provided during the exhibit. Neither The West Colfax Event Center, the E Project, nor the Lakewood Arts Council may be held liable for loss of or damage to artwork.
